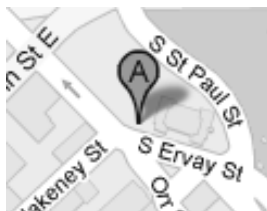

THE MISSIONARIES



R. BALA

Pastor Bala was born in Sri Lanka in a family of four children. He was converted to Christ from a traditional Hindu background in 1978 while attending university. Having completed a degree in Agricultural Economics and being convinced of the call of God, he completed a theological education at South Wales Bible College in Wales, United Kingdom. The providence of God led him and his family to New Zealand where he took up the pastorate of Sovereign Grace Church in Auckland and has remained as a pastor of that church for the past 24 years.

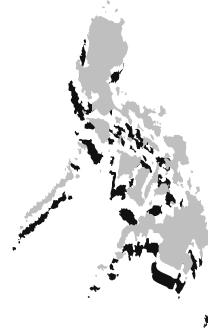
In 1990 he began to minister among the Tamil-speaking people in **India and Sri Lanka**. This ministry has spread to several other countries. He makes several visits each year to these countries and focuses on planting churches, and training men for the ministry. Pastor Bala is the editor of *Bible Lamp*, which produces literature in the Tamil language. He is married to Sharmini, and they have two adult children, Seshani and Shehan.



STEVE HOFMAIER

Pastor Steve Hofmaier was born in New Orleans, Louisiana, and attended the First Baptist Church there from birth until moving to New Jersey at age 14. He was converted before entering his senior year of high school in that state. While studying Chemical Engineering at the University of Delaware, he learned of the Doctrines of Grace from fellow students. There he was also involved in leading student Bible studies, which led to interest in the Christian ministry.

After working for 2 years in the Engineering field, he entered the Trinity Ministerial Academy, finishing his studies in 1981. He served for 6 months in Kenya, and then taught at Trinity Ministerial Academy for two years. It was during this time that he met Brian Ellis, an English missionary to **the Philippines**. This contact resulted in a visit to these islands in 1983, which God used in turn to make clear a call to that country. Pastor Hofmaier has labored there since 1984 in church planting and ministerial instruction. He was used to plant the Moonwalk Community Bible Church, and to start the Reformed Baptist Institute of Pastoral Training. He has been married to his wife, Carol, since 1983; they have two adult children currently residing in the USA.

PACO OROZCO

Pastor Paco Orozco grew up in **Mexico** in a nominally Catholic family. When he was 9 years old, a missionary family shared the gospel with his family. As a teenager, he came to the United States to study medicine, but the Lord challenged him to minister to men's souls instead.

After finishing his ministerial studies, Pastor Orozco returned to his hometown of Hermosillo and started the Iglesia Biblica Monte Horeb. He has pastored there for the past 25 years. Pastor Orozco, his wife Julia, and their children are encouraged by the Lord's promise that He will build His Church.
